Need for a Peak Body was identified by career practitioners and academics in response to 1992 MCEEYTA statements about career education



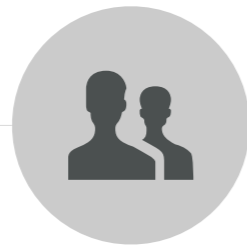
2000

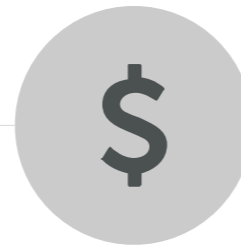
National Consultation Process was conducted on National Standards managed by Miles Morgan. Standards were written based on Association input and feedback

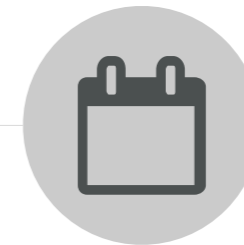
Commissioned a report on the Economic Benefits of Career Development by Access Economics

Government contract awarded to run National Career Development Week until 2010



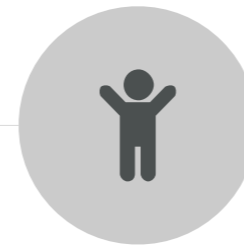

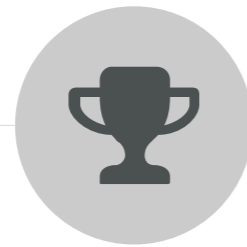
