LMIP User Guide

The LMIP User Guide is designed to help users navigate the new-look LMIP and find relevant information.

Content on the LMIP is categorized into three distinct sections (see Figure 1):

1. Explore the data

Explore regional labour market information – by three geographical classifications - using interactive maps.

2. Gain insights

View a range of reports, publications and other content produced by the Department of Employment. Information available includes: Employment Projections, the monthly Vacancy Report and the Department of Employment's state Labour Economics Office reports.

3. Downloads

Download a range of data files – including regional information available from the Explore the data channel.

Explore the data

Explore labour market information for three geographical classifications: Employment Regions (ERs), Employment Service Areas (ESAs) and ABS Statistical Area 4 (SA4) Regions. There are two ways to access regional information from the **Explore the data** section:

- 1. Explore the data menu (see Figure 2)
 - i) Hover over the **Explore the data** menu tab.
 - ii) Choose one of the geographical classifications and then select a corresponding sub-region using the collapsible arrows.

- 2. Explore regional data menu located on the Homepage(see Figure 3)
 - i) Use the left drop-down menu to select a geographical classification.
 - ii) Then select a corresponding sub-region using the right drop-down menu.
 - iii) Once you have selected a region, click the View charts & maps button.

After selecting a region from one of the aforementioned menus, you will enter the **Explore the data** mapping-section of the website. The **Explore the data** section contains an interactive map (on the left) and a data pane (on the right). The interactive map can be used to pan/zoom and select regions by clicking on them. From the data pane, you can access the following:

- 1. A brief labour market summary of the selected region.
- 2. A link to a list of charts and data available for the selected region.

Explore the data - Charts

After selecting the "View charts and tabular data" link from the data pane, you will go to a new page with a list of charts available. From this page, you can access the following features:

- **1.** An array of charts from the left menu. Simply click on a link to populate the chart to the right.
- 2. Expandable/collapsible window that contains the source information.
- **3.** A link to the **Downloads** section where data can be downloaded in Excel files.
- **4.** A link to print the chart/table.
